

## MENS' HOSTEL

Boys' hostel stone laid by Hon., Education Minister Sri. K. Chandrasekaran of Sri. E. K. Nayanar Ministry on 17<sup>th</sup> Nov 1990, in the presence of Sri. Sivadasamenon (Hon., Minister for Power & Rural Development), Sri. A. Vijaya Raghavan M P and C M Sundaram MLA. Students Hostel Building inaugurated by Sri. E. T. Muhammed Bhasheer (Hon., Minister of Education ) on 25<sup>th</sup> July 1992.

The primary objectives of establishing hostels for boys is to provide students a home away from their home. The hostels are built in an environment that certainly helps to build self-confidence and instills discipline in the minds of students. The hostel ambience provides scope for developing harmonious communal living and enables them to share the joy of unity and professional fraternity, self help and co operation. Everyone should uphold the dignity and self respect of every other students in the hostel.

The mens' hostel situated near by the main campus. Boys hostel accommodates hundred students at a time. The hostel is administered by a hostel committee. The committee includes Principal (Warden), Resident Tutor, Senior faculty, a parent, mess chairman, mess treasurer and other members to assist administration of the hostel. The student committee and the hostel office work together in coordinating the hostel activities. Hostel committee and office bearers ensure the smooth functioning of the hostel.

The hostels are well furnished and equipped with a dining hall accommodating hundred students at a time. Hostels have purified water supply for the drinking purpose. Hostel has a cable connected LED TV, news paper in the recreation room. Mess facilities are made available for boys with good balanced food at reasonable rate. Twenty four hours security is available at hostel. The students are encouraged to participate in cultural activities, sports and games. We have volleyball and badminton court.

Hostel admission is purely based on Kerala Govt norms. The mess is run on a dividing system and the members of the mess committee decided to weekly menu in consultation with other members. The items required for the menu are purchased from the suppliers and the stock are entered in a book. The items delivered to the cooking staff. After the preparation of food update the balance in the stock book. The committee also discuss the requirements for the hostel developments with the administration.

In shortly our hostel features large rooms with separate coats shared bathrooms in both floors. A communal kitchen, guest room, study room and recreation room.
